




Continuous oiling of the pneumatic tools is important in order to maintain high performances and to prevent damages on the piston and the cylinder.

***IR paving breakers
and IR PV pickhammers***Use the **built-in lubricator**

Check the oil level before using the tool:

- Unscrew the yellow cap
- Fill with oil if necessary
- Check oil levels every 2 hours of use

All other pneumatic toolsUse an **inline lubricator** (cpn 35371111)

- The inline lubricator is located between 3 and 5 metres upstream of the tool.
- The oil level must be controlled daily.
- Also valid for paving breakers if the built-in lubricator is not used

- We recommend 10W40 PRO-TEC oil for lubrication (cpn 85448405, 5 l)
- In case of ice blocking the piston, use special oil: 'Kill-Frost' (cpn 35379718, 500 ml).
- Make sure that the tool is not over-lubricated as this might create moving parts to stick.
- Always close open air hoses in order to prevent sand and dirt from entering.
