Effective 1 August 1998, Portable Compressor Division Products Operation, Maintenance and Parts Manuals will no longer exhibit a serial number range on the front of the manual.

Instead, when changes occur, they will be documented in the parts illustrations with appropriate serial number breaks indicated on the page. The old page will remain in the book and will also be identified by applicable serial numbers. The parts section will contain the history of that model as it evolves with time.

Current manuals will not be modified to include all past changes, but will be all inclusive for future changes as of 1 August 1998.

Machines shipped prior to 1 August 1998 continue to require the use of serialized manuals for the most accurate information.

The CD Rom Parts ID Manager will incorporate this same format as it is updated.

The manual users must use the correct serial number illustrations throughout the manuals to assure correct parts information.

The serial number information will be set in large bold print in the center top portion of the applicable pages (See example on back). Pages with no serial number information indicates, that page is applicable to all serial number ranges.
