Subject: Removing K4 relay from control panel

MODELS AFFECTED: TELECOM GENSET MODELS N40 through N60 with a K4

relay in lower area of Control Panel

SYMPTOMS: Unit will not start after sitting idle or in Auto for more than 6 hours.

CAUSE: K4 relay is applying constant power to engine ECU.

REMEDY: 1. Remove K4 relay from the Circuit (located in the bottom of the control panel pedestal), tie up wires. Please note this will disable the water temp readings on the unit when it is not running and may result in a water temp alarm upon starting, this is the permanent solution to this issue. If K 4 is not present no action needs to be taken.

WARRANTY ACTION: Claims we be accepted until 6-1-06 for 1 hr. labor and actual travel time. Reference campaign # 05-6 on the claim.
